## Protecting the WRS

When the state legislature raided the Wisconsin Retirement System, the Wisconsin Supreme Court ruled the raid illegal and ordered the state to repay the money, plus interest. It was our organization that fought for 10 years and invested 5,000 hours of legal work in the case to protect retired educators.

Today, WEAC Region 10/Retired continues to be vigilant, working with the Wisconsin Coalition of Annuity and other like-minded groups to preserve the integrity of the WRS so educators have secure futures after dedicating a lifetime to students.
